David started out at Oxford Scientific Films (OSF), then moved to Australia, Norway (Svalbard), and is now based on the East coast of the US. He also has a production office in Reykjavik, Iceland.

David regularly shoots assignments throughout N.America, as well as internationally.

In addition, he also helps lead expedition trips to the Arctic for National Geographic / Lindblad, with three major trips planned for 2021 to Svalbard and Iceland, Previous destinations also include the Falklands, South Georgia, Australia and the Antarctic.
